

# THE HOLY POST

## 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time — Year C October 5, 2025

FIRST READING: How long, Lord, will you make me witness misery?  
(Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4)

PSALM: "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." (Psalm 95)

SECOND READING: Guard the rich deposit of faith you were given.  
(2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14)

GOSPEL: When you have done everything for the kingdom, do more.  
(Luke 17:5-10)

Each week we gather here as a family of faith, but probably do not know how strong our faith is until we put it to the test. We have had occasions to rely on as much faith as we can muster to cope with the grief of the loss of a loved one, to overcome an addition, or to survive a tragedy in our lives. Unlike the apostles, today we have the advantage of knowing that God is stronger than death, that Jesus is the resurrection and the life, and that the Holy Spirit is with us forever. Listen for God's reassuring voice, and keep the faith!
