


Due to a significant price increase, we are changing our website hosting provider. At this time, our parish website (holyghostvinita.org) is still available while we transition to and build our new website.

THE HOLY POST

All Souls' Day — Year C

November 2, 2025

FIRST READING: No torment shall touch the souls of the just. *(Wisdom 3:1-9)*

PSALM: "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want." *(Psalm 23)*

SECOND READING: Justified by his blood, we will be saved through Christ from the wrath. *(Romans 5:5-11)*

GOSPEL: "Everyone who believes in the Son will have eternal life." *(John 6:37-40)*

Jesus told his disciples, "Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted." Today we mourn all those who have died, especially those we love, those who are close to us. But we indeed are comforted: By our memories of them, by sharing our grief with loved ones, and by our faith, which tells us that death is not the end. Their souls are in the arms of God, forever comforted from the suffering and hardships they faced in life. Our faith in the Resurrection allows us to be pilgrims of hope in this life, placing our trust in God's love and mercy.
