passed away from this life on May 3, 2026. He was born to David and Margaret Edmiston on October 3, 1925, in Ponca City, Oklahoma. He was born as the 3rd son followed by 4 girls. After graduating from Marquette Catholic High School in Tulsa, he attended Oklahoma State University where he joined Theta Kappa Phi. He enlisted into the US Army Air Corps (now the US AirForce) and was called to service October 26th, 1943, and joined the World War II campaign in the Pacific on the island of Saipan. After the war he returned to Oklahoma State University where he met his wife, Dolores Joy Ravaioli. After they graduated, they married and had 6 children. They lived in Tulsa, Oklahoma City and Houston.

He retired from WellTech as Vice President and returned to Oklahoma City where they joined Epiphany of The Lord Catholic Church. As a couple they were involved in St Vincent's DePaul Society, volunteers at the Oklahoma Heart Hospital, several dance clubs, and were Avid Worldwide travelers. Dolores passed away July 17th, 2012. He is survived by their 6 children and their spouses, 12 of the 14 grandchildren and their spouses and 13 great grandchildren.
